

D-RMSL Volunteers Provide Warm Welcome, Tours



The Marcus Neuroscience Institute recently opened at Boca Raton Regional Hospital and D-RMSL volunteers have already made a lasting impression. In addition to our volunteers welcoming patients and visitors daily in the main lobby, our Ambassadors led tours of the 56,000-squarefoot facility during a special preview event for Boca Regional physicians, employees and volunteers on October 30.

A new nexus of neurological care in South Florida, the Institute was created out of a lead \$25 million grant from the Marcus Foundation and initiated by Billi and Bernie Marcus, former CEO of The Home Depot. The facility houses a 20-bed Neuro Intensive Care and Intermediate Intensive Care unit, as well as four dedicated operating rooms, one equipped with intraoperative MRI and two with intraoperative CT capabilities. State-of-theart private patient rooms feature special monitoring equipment, and the Neuro Intensive Care Unit rooms each include an antechamber for families.
