Time to Prepare for The Joint Commission Compliance

As in past years, we will have mandatory orientation for all D-RMSL volunteers. In order to remain in active status, you must attend this important presentation. Kathy Davis, ARNP, Employee Health Nurse, will be on hand 10 minutes prior to each orientation to administer Tuberculosis (TB) tests to volunteers who have patient contact and require the screenings. Each session will last approximately 60 to 90 minutes. Light refreshments will be served.
